

Accommodation

The camp has six heated cabins that accommodate from 5-14 people for a total of 64 beds available for winter use. An extra five summer cabins provide another 40 beds for a total of 104 beds for the summer season.



In addition, there are areas suitable for tents for those who wish to "camp out". The Tiger Showers building with sixteen showers and a sauna is available for use from May to October. Running water and indoor washroom facilities are available year-round in the main lodge.

Facilities

The central focus of the camp is a large dining hall complete with fireplace and a fully equipped kitchen with all required utensils and support materials present.



Waterfront facilities include a beach, multi-level dock, diving board and swimming area. Adjacent to the beach, the large boat house contains canoes, paddle boats and aluminum row boats and is an ideal location for a crafts program.



The 10 acre property offers your group varied terrain that encourages nature walks, orientation programs and large-scale games. A large campfire site is perfect for marshmallows and ghost stories.

Activities

Camp Endobanah supports a full range of summer activities from swimming, diving, boating and fishing to nature walks, orientation, sports, crafts, stargazing and campfires. Winter activities include skating, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and ice-fishing.

The camp is ideal for a church group retreat. An outdoor chapel and ample room in the lodge support worship services and bible studies.
